




# ***SAVED* Declarations**







and the waters were divided.**

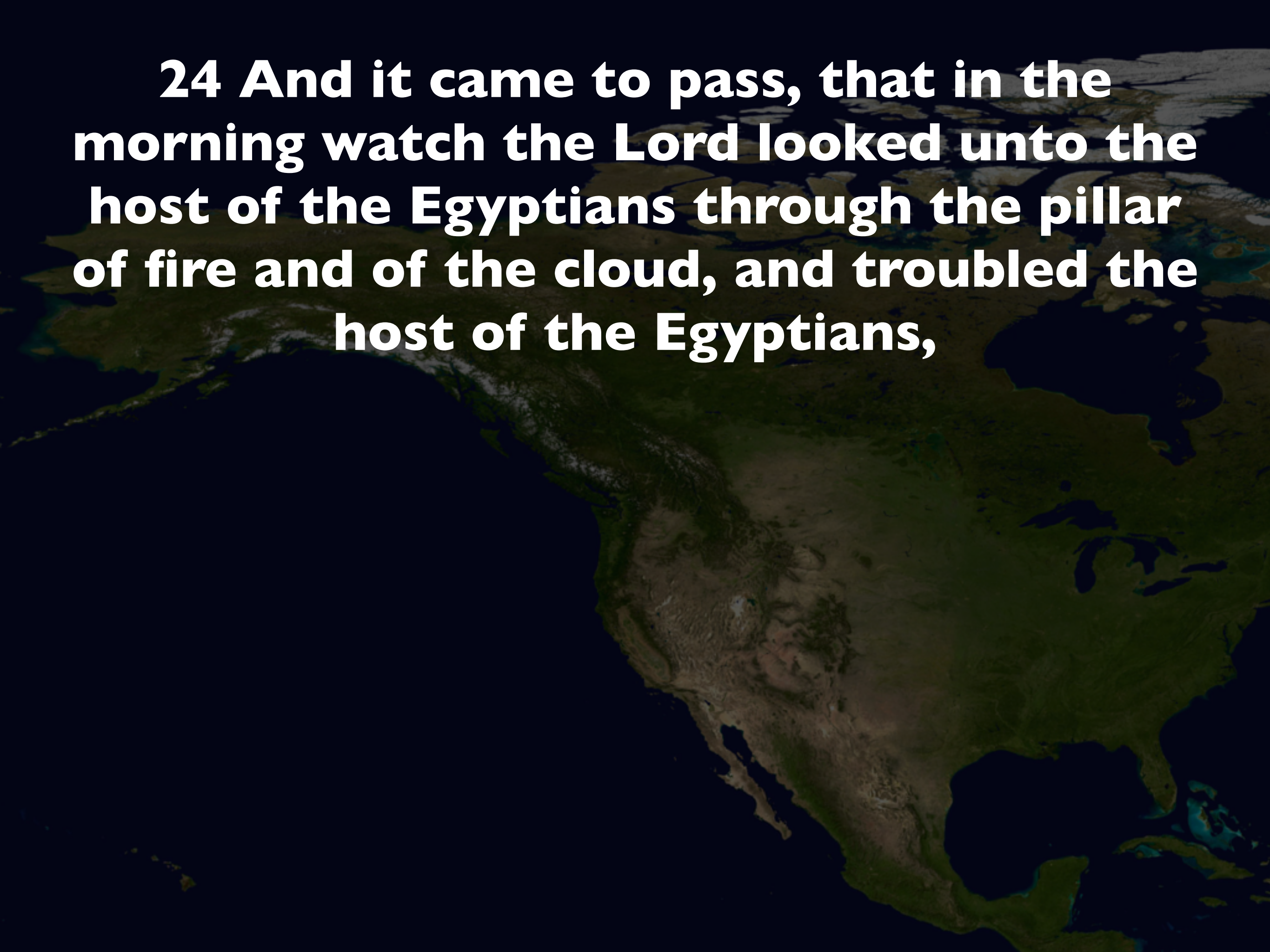

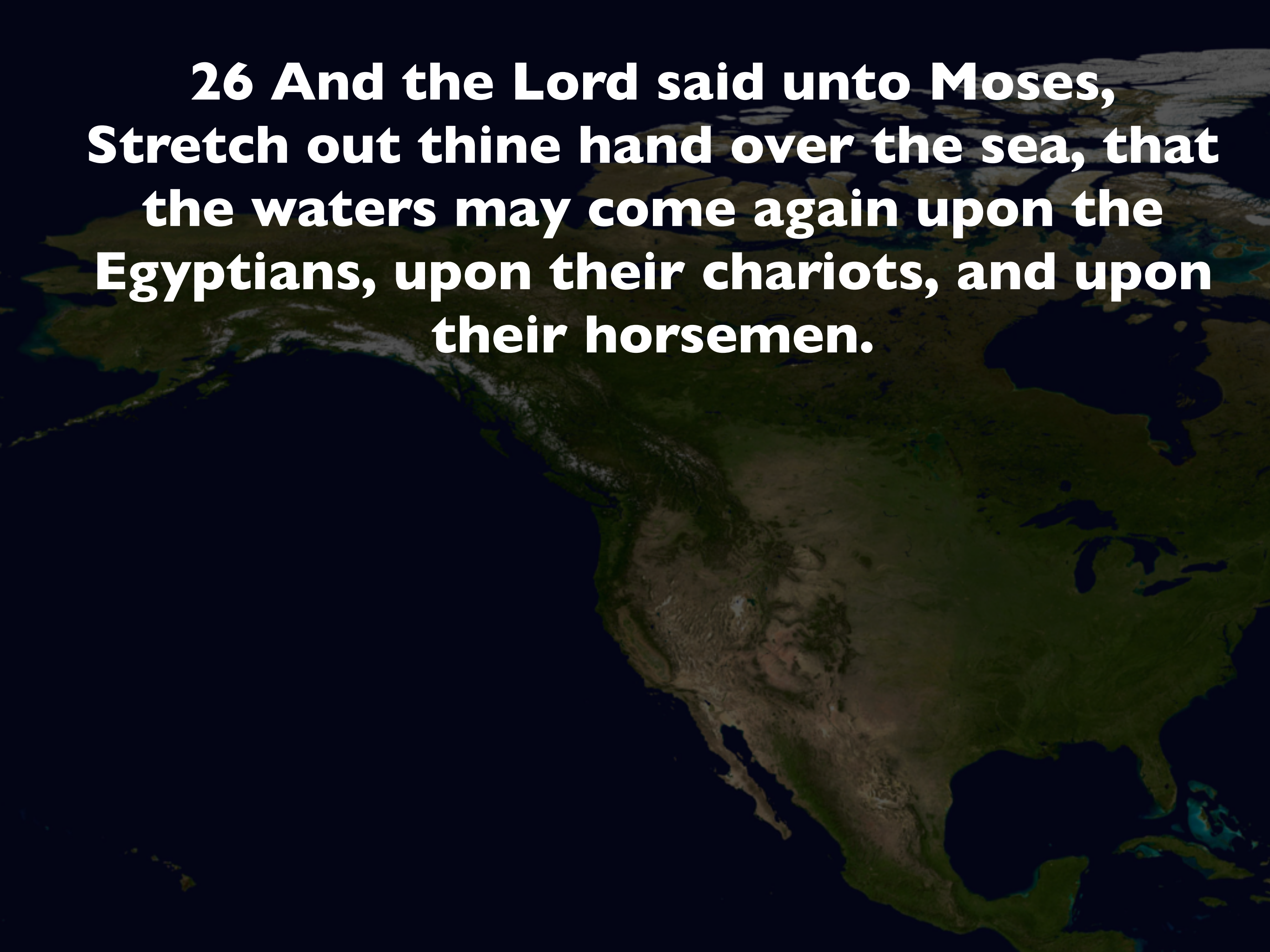


**25 And took off their chariot wheels,


**\*America, if ye go to war in your land


**\* There is none like unto the God of

**28 Israel and America then shall dwell in safety alone: the fountain of Jacob shall be upon a land of corn and wine; also his heavens shall drop down dew.**





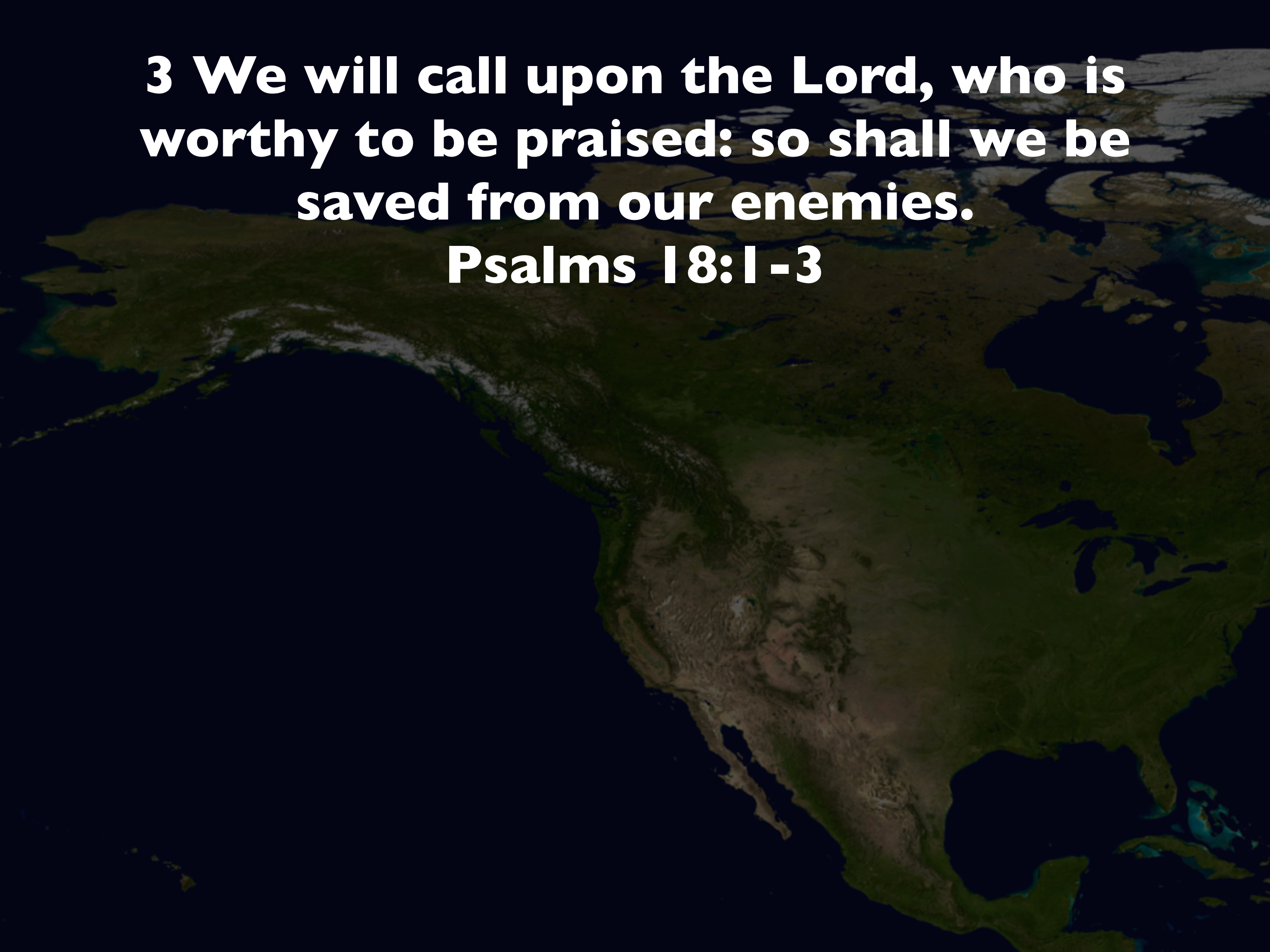


**\* We Say America will love thee, O Lord,







them from the hand of the enemy.**

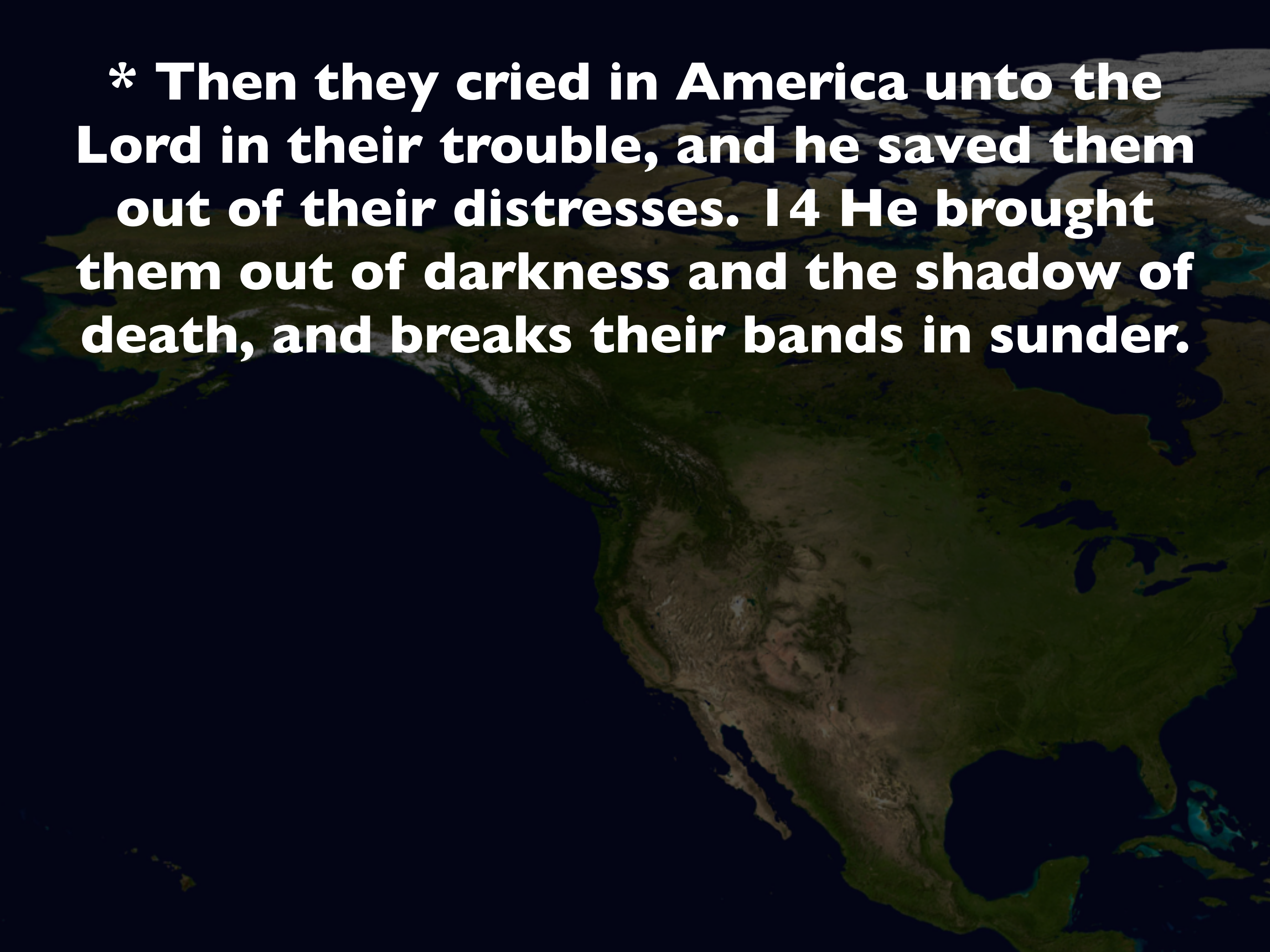
