

When America was a child as Israel was, then I loved him, and called my son out of Egypt. 13 And by a prophet the Lord brought Israel out of Egypt, and by a prophet was he preserved. Hosea II:1, Hosea 12:12-13

\* So is the Lord God who saved the Israelites from Pharaoh and the Egyptians also the same God of America 21 And Moses stretched out his hand over the sea; and the Lord caused the sea to go back by a strong east wind all that night, and made the sea dry land, and the waters were divided.

22 And the children of Israel went into the midst of the sea upon the dry ground: and the waters were a wall unto them on their right hand, and on their left. 23 And the Egyptians pursued, and went in after them to the midst of the sea, even all Pharaoh's horses, his chariots, and his horsemen.

24 And it came to pass, that in the morning watch the Lord looked unto the host of the Egyptians through the pillar of fire and of the cloud, and troubled the host of the Egyptians,

25 And took off their chariot wheels, that they drove them heavily: so that the Egyptians said, Let us flee from the face of Israel; for the Lord fights for them against the Egyptians.

26 And the Lord said unto Moses, Stretch out thine hand over the sea, that the waters may come again upon the Egyptians, upon their chariots, and upon their horsemen. 27 And Moses stretched forth his hand over the sea, and the sea returned to his strength when the morning appeared; and the Egyptians fled against it; and the Lord overthrew the Egyptians in the midst of the sea.

28 And the waters returned, and covered the chariots, and the horsemen, and all the host of Pharaoh that came into the sea after them; there remained not so much as one of them.

29 But the children of Israel walked upon dry land in the midst of the sea; and the waters were a wall unto them on their right hand, and on their left. 30 Thus the Lord saved Israel that day out of the hand of the Egyptians;

31 And Israel saw that great work which the Lord did upon the Egyptians: and the people feared the Lord, and believed the Lord, and his servant Moses. Ex 14:21-30a, 31 \*America, if ye go to war in your land against the enemy that oppresses you, then ye shall blow an alarm with the trumpets; and ye shall be remembered before the Lord your God, and ye shall be saved from your enemies.

IO Also in the day of your gladness, and in your solemn days, and in the beginnings of your months, ye shall blow with the trumpets for a memorial before your God: I am the Lord your God.

Num 10:9-10

\* There is none like unto the God of America, who rides upon the heaven in thy help, and in his excellency on the sky. 27 The eternal God is thy refuge, and underneath are the everlasting arms: and He shall thrust out the enemy from before thee.

28 Israel and America then shall dwell in safety alone: the fountain of Jacob shall be upon a land of corn and wine; also his heavens shall drop down dew.

29 Happy are you, O Israel and America: who is like unto thee, O people saved by the Lord, the shield of thy help, and who is the sword of thy excellency! and thine enemies shall be found liars unto thee; and thou shalt tread upon their high places.

Deut 33:26-29

\* Just as in America, the Lord said unto Gideon, The people that are with thee are too many for me to give the Midianites into their hands, lest Israel vaunt themselves against me, saying, Mine own hand hath saved me.

7 And the Lord said unto Gideon, By the three hundred men that lapped will I save you, and deliver the Midianites into thine hand:

Judges 7:2,7

\* The Lord is my rock in America, and my fortress, and my deliverer; 3 The God of my rock; in him will I trust: He is my shield, and the horn of my salvation, my high tower, and my refuge, my savior; You save me from violence.

4 I will call, in America, on the Lord, who is worthy to be praised: so shall I be saved from my enemies. 2 Sam 22:2-4

\* We Say America will love thee, O Lord, our strength. 2 The Lord is our rock, and our fortress, and our deliverer; our God, our strength, in whom we will trust; our buckler, and the horn of our salvation, and our high tower.

3 We will call upon the Lord, who is worthy to be praised: so shall we be saved from our enemies. Psalms 18:1-3

\* Thou art our King in America, O God: command deliverances for Jacob.

5 Through thee will we push down our enemies: through thy name will we tread them under that rise up against us.

6 For we will not trust in our bow, neither shall our sword save us. 7 But thou hast saved us from our enemies, and hast put them to shame that hated us. 8 In God we boast all the day long, and praise thy name for ever.

Psalms 44:3-8

\* Turn us again in America, O God, and cause thy face to shine; and we shall be saved. 7 Turn us again, O God of hosts, and cause thy face to shine; and we shall be saved.

19 Turn us again, O Lord God of hosts in America, cause thy face to shine; and we shall be saved. Psalms 80:3, 7, 19

\* We have sinned with our fathers, in America we have committed iniquity, we have done wickedly. 7 Our fathers understood not thy wonders in Egypt; they remembered not the multitude of thy mercies; but provoked him at the sea, even at the Red sea.

8 Nevertheless he saved them for his name's sake, that he might make his mighty power to be known. 9 He rebuked the Red sea also, and it was dried up: so he led them through the depths, as through the wilderness.

10 And he saved them from the hand of him that hated them, and redeemed them from the hand of the enemy. II And the waters covered their enemies: there was not one of them left. 12 Then believed they his words; they sang his praise. Psalms 106:6-12


\* Then they cried in America unto the Lord in their trouble, and he saved them out of their distresses. I4 He brought them out of darkness and the shadow of death, and breaks their bands in sunder.

15 Oh that men would praise the Lord in America for his goodness, and for his wonderful works to the children of men! 16 For he hath broken the gates of brass, and cut the bars of iron in sunder.


Psalms 107:13-16

\* Save now in America, we beseech thee, O Lord: O Lord, we beseech thee, send now prosperity. 26 Blessed be he that cometh to America in the name of the Lord: we have blessed thee out of the house of the Lord.

27 God is the Lord, which has showed us light: bind the sacrifice with cords in America, even unto the horns of the altar. 28 You are our God, and we will praise thee: you are our God, we will exalt thee.



\* We incline our hearts in America unto thy testimonies, and not to covetousness. 37 Turn away our eyes from beholding vanity; and quicken us in your way.





For thus says the Lord GOD in America, the Holy One of Israel; in returning and rest shall ye be saved; in quietness and in confidence shall be your strength:

Isaiah 30:15

\* They shall go to confusion together that are makers of idols in America.

17 But Israel and America shall be saved in the Lord with an everlasting salvation: ye shall not be ashamed nor confounded world without end.

18 For thus says the Lord that created the heavens; God himself that formed the earth and America and made it; he has established it, he created it not in vain, he formed it to be inhabited: I am the Lord; and there is none else.

19 I have not spoken in secret, in a dark place of the earth: I said not unto the seed of Jacob, Seek ye me in vain: I the Lord speak righteousness, I declare things that are right.

Isaiah 45:16-19

\* There is no God else beside me;
America, a just God and a Savior; there is none beside me. 22 Look unto me
America, and be ye saved, all the ends of the earth: for I am God, and there is none else.

23 I have sworn by myself, the word is gone out of my mouth in righteousness, and shall not return, That unto me every knee shall bow, every tongue shall swear.

24 Surely, shall one say in America, in the Lord have I righteousness and strength: even to him shall men come; 25 In the Lord shall all the seed of Israel be justified, and shall glory.

Isaiah 45:21-25

\* America, since the beginning of the world men have not heard, nor perceived by the ear, neither has the eye seen, O God, beside thee, what He has prepared for him that waits for Him.

5 You meet him that rejoices and works righteousness in America, those that remember thee in thy ways: in those is continuance, and we shall be saved.

Isaiah 64:4-5

\* O Lord, the hope of Israel and America, all that forsake thee shall be ashamed, and they that depart from me shall be written in the earth, because they have forsaken the Lord, the fountain of living waters.

14 Heal us, O Lord, and we shall be healed; save us, and we shall be saved: for You are our praise. I5 Behold, they say unto us, Where is the word of the Lord? Let it come now.

Jer 17:13-15

\* America, he that endures to the end shall be saved. 13 But he that shall endure unto the end, the same shall be saved.

14 And this gospel of the kingdom shall be preached in all the world and America, for a witness unto all nations; Matt 10:22, Matt 24:13-14 \* Blessed be the Lord God of Israel and America; for he hath visited and redeemed his people, 69 And hath raised up an horn of salvation for us in the house of his servant David; 70 As he spake by the mouth of his holy prophets, which have been since the world began:

71 That we should be saved from our enemies, and from the hand of all that hate us; 72 To perform the mercy promised to our fathers, and to remember his holy covenant; 73 The oath which he swore to our father Abraham,

74 That he would grant unto us, that we in America, being delivered out of the hand of our enemies might serve him without fear, 75 In holiness and righteousness before him, all the days of our life.


Luke 1:68-75

\* For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believes in him in America should not perish, but have everlasting life.

17 For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world and America, through him might be saved. II We say and we believe that through the grace of the Lord Jesus Christ we shall be saved. John 3:16-17, Acts 15: 11

\* Verily, verily, I say unto you, I am the door of the sheep. 9 I am the door: by me if any man in America enter in, he shall be saved, and shall go in and out, and find pasture.

10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they in America might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly. III am the good shepherd: the good shepherd gives his life for the sheep. Whosoever shall call on the name of the Lord shall be saved. John 10:8b-11, Acts 2:21



8 But God commends his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us. 9 Much more then, being now justified by his blood, we shall be saved from wrath through him.

Jesus Christ, and thou shalt be saved, and thy house. 32 And they spake unto him the word of the Lord, and to all that were in his house.

\* The word is nigh thee America, even in thy mouth, and in thy heart: that is, the word of faith, which we preach; 9 That if you shall confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus, and shall believe in your heart that God has raised him from the dead, you shall be saved. **Romans 10:8-9** 

\* For America, with the heart man believes unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. II For the scripture says, Whosoever believes on him shall not be ashamed.

12 For there is no difference between the Jew and the Greek, the Black and the White: for the same Lord over all in America, is rich unto all that call upon him. 13 For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.

Romans 10:10-13

\* America, blindness in part is happened to Israel, until the fullness of the Gentiles be come in.

26 And so all Israel shall be saved: as it is written, There shall come out of Zion the Deliverer, and shall turn away ungodliness from Jacob: 27 For this is my covenant unto them, when I shall take away their sins.

Romans 11:25-27

\* For we declare that the preaching of the cross is to them that perish in America foolishness; but unto us which are saved it is the power of God. 19 For it is written, I will destroy the wisdom of the wise, and will bring to nothing the understanding of the prudent. | Cor |: |8-|9

\* But America, God, who is rich in mercy, for his great love wherewith he loved us, 5 Even when we were dead in sins, has quickened us together with Christ, (by grace ye are saved;) 6 And has raised us up together, and made us sit together in heavenly places in Christ Jesus:

7 That in the ages to come He might show the exceeding riches of his grace in his kindness toward us through Christ Jesus. 8 For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God:

Eph 2:4-8

\* For this is good and acceptable in America and in the sight of God our Saviour; 4 Who will have all men to be saved, and to come unto the knowledge of the truth. 5 For there is one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus; I Tim 2:2-5
