



*Scriptural Declarations **STRONG IN THE LORD***






*** We declare 6 Be strong and of a good

Deut 31:6, 8b




*** I will not fail thee, nor forsake thee

I swore unto their fathers to give them.**




**7 Only America, be thou strong and very

Josh 1:5-7



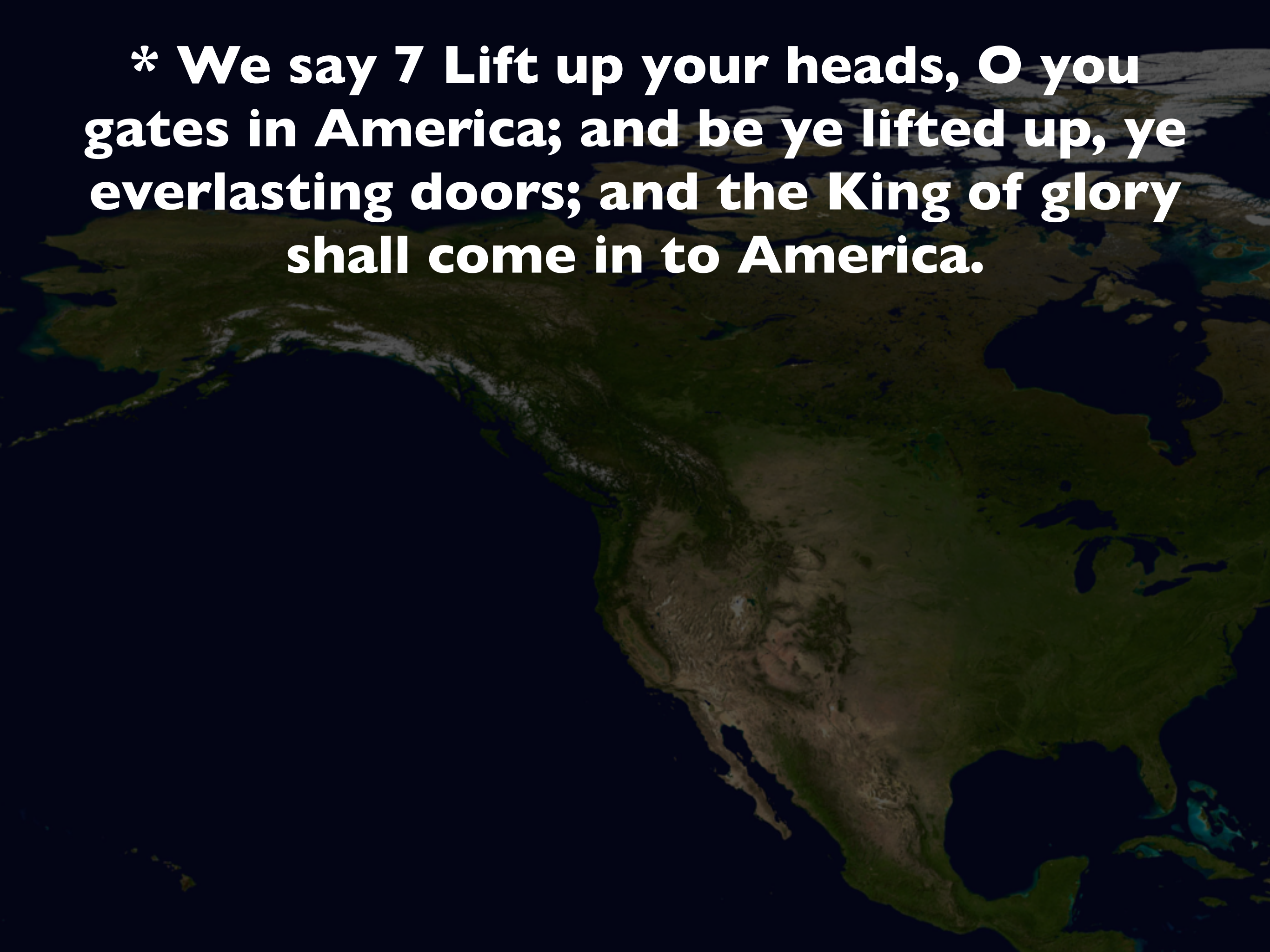
**We declare that 8 This book of the law

success.**




**9 Have not I commanded you America?

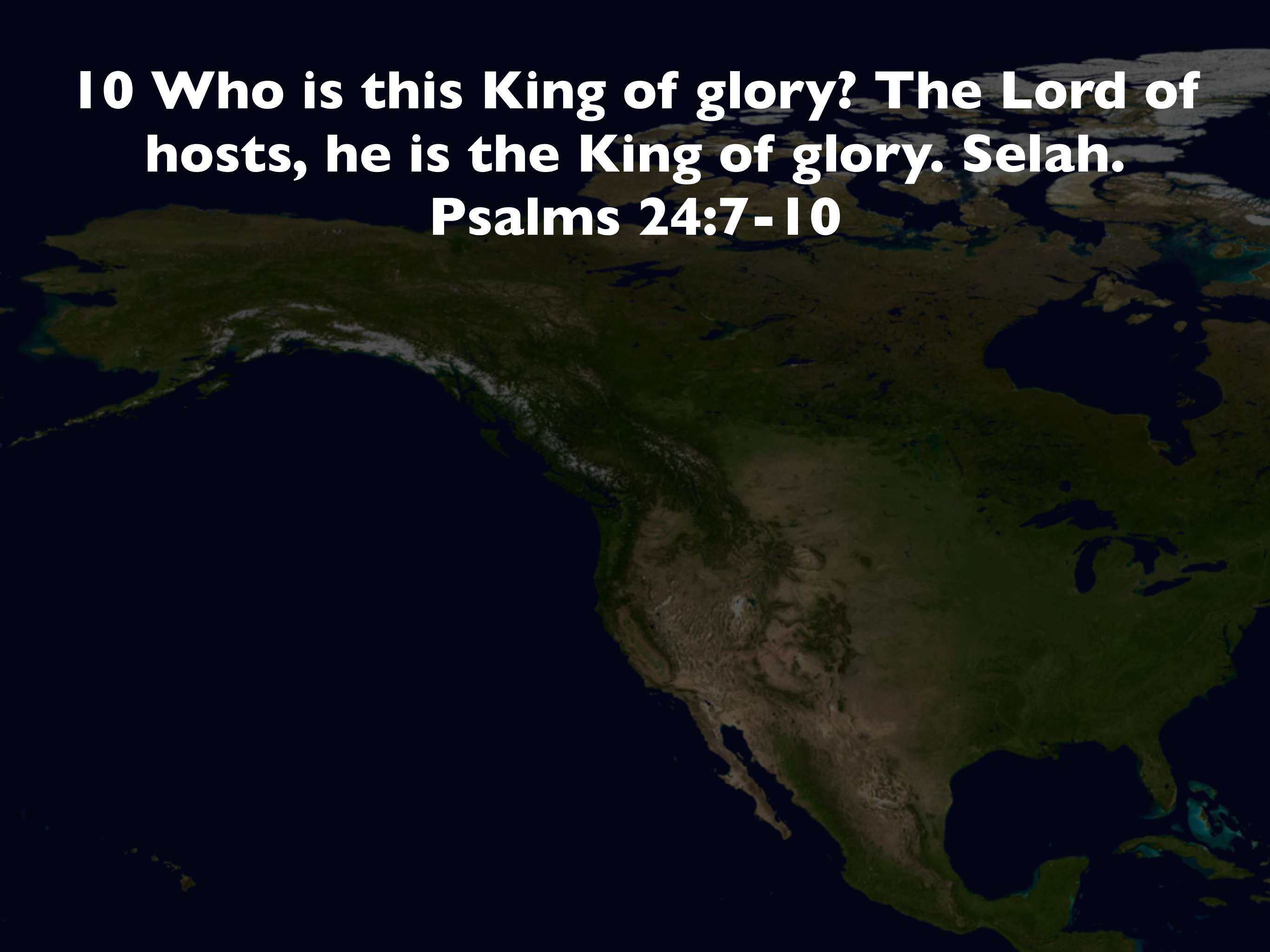
*** We say 7 Lift up your heads, O you

shall come in to America.**



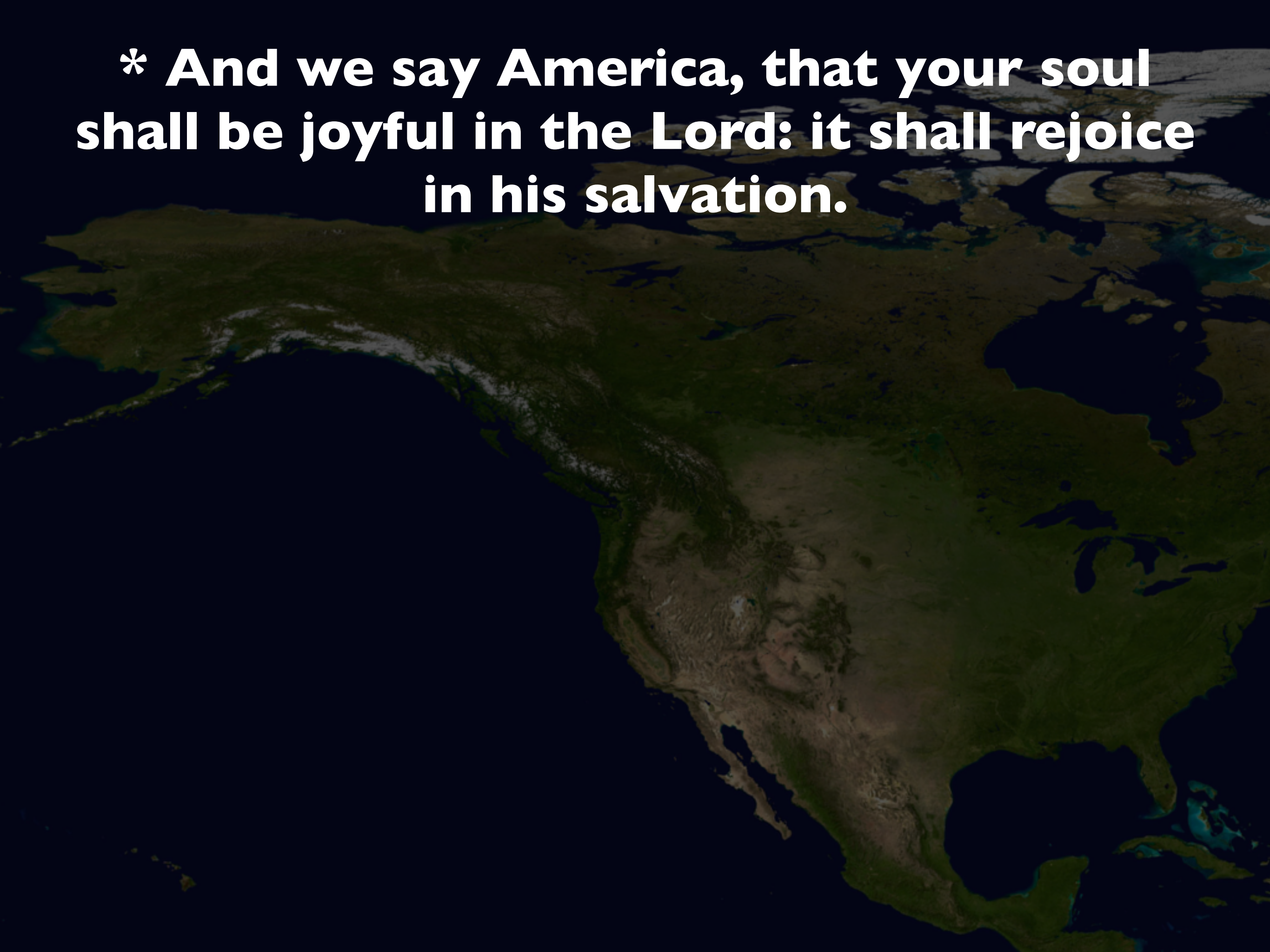
**8 Who is this King of glory? The Lord

doors; and the King of glory shall come in.**




*** And we say America, that your soul

in his salvation.**






**10 All your bones America shall say,

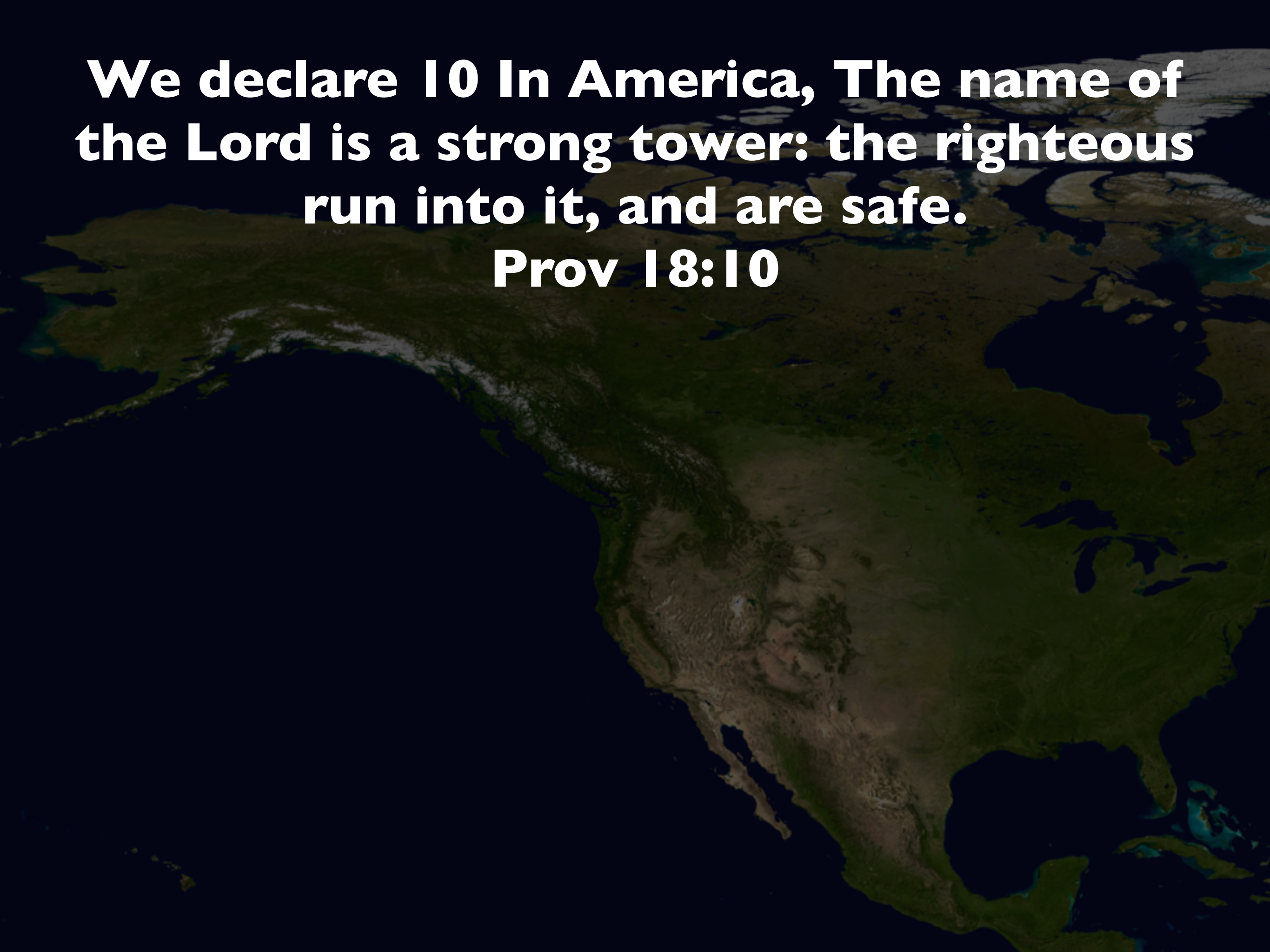

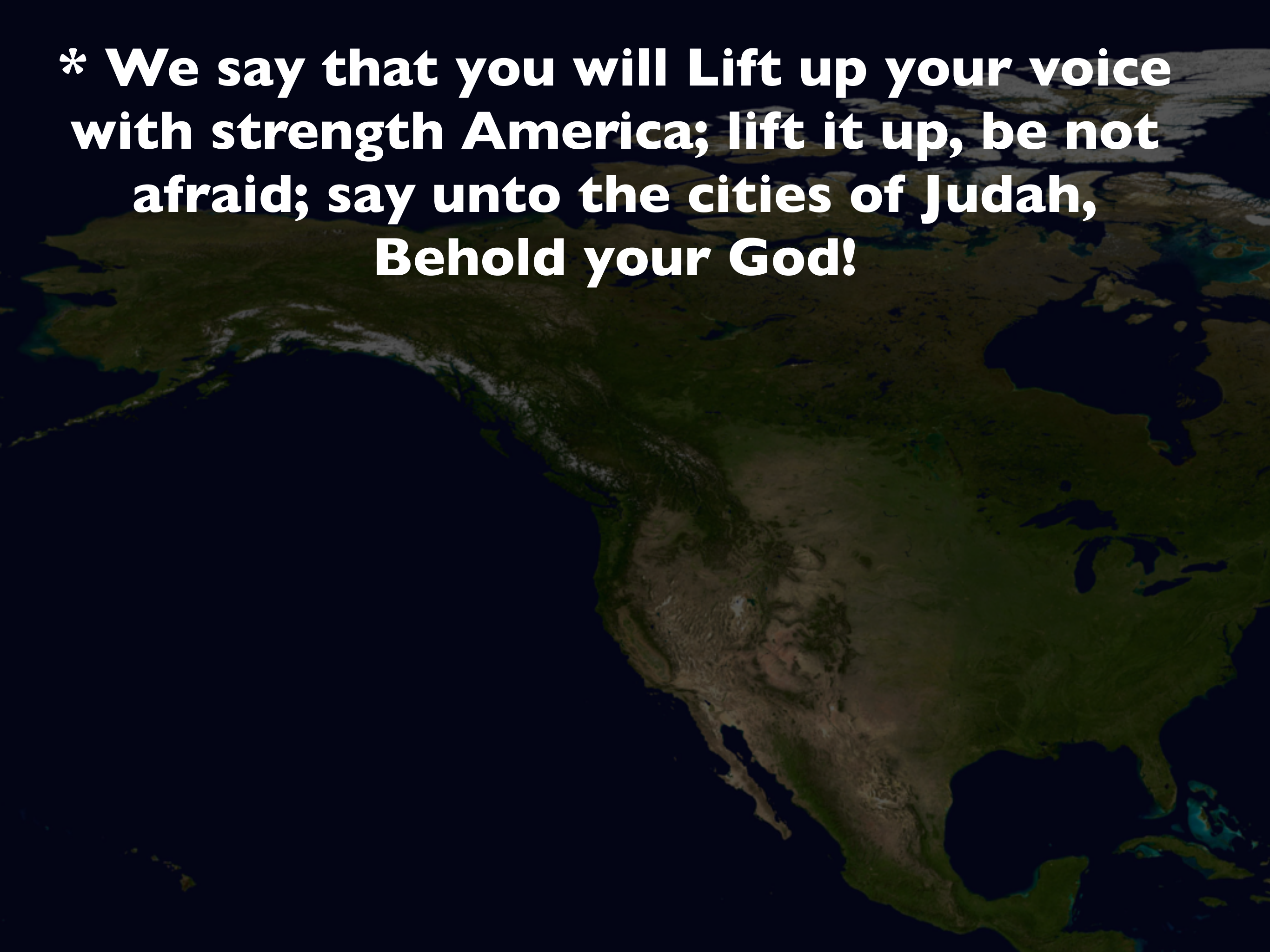

run into it, and are safe.**

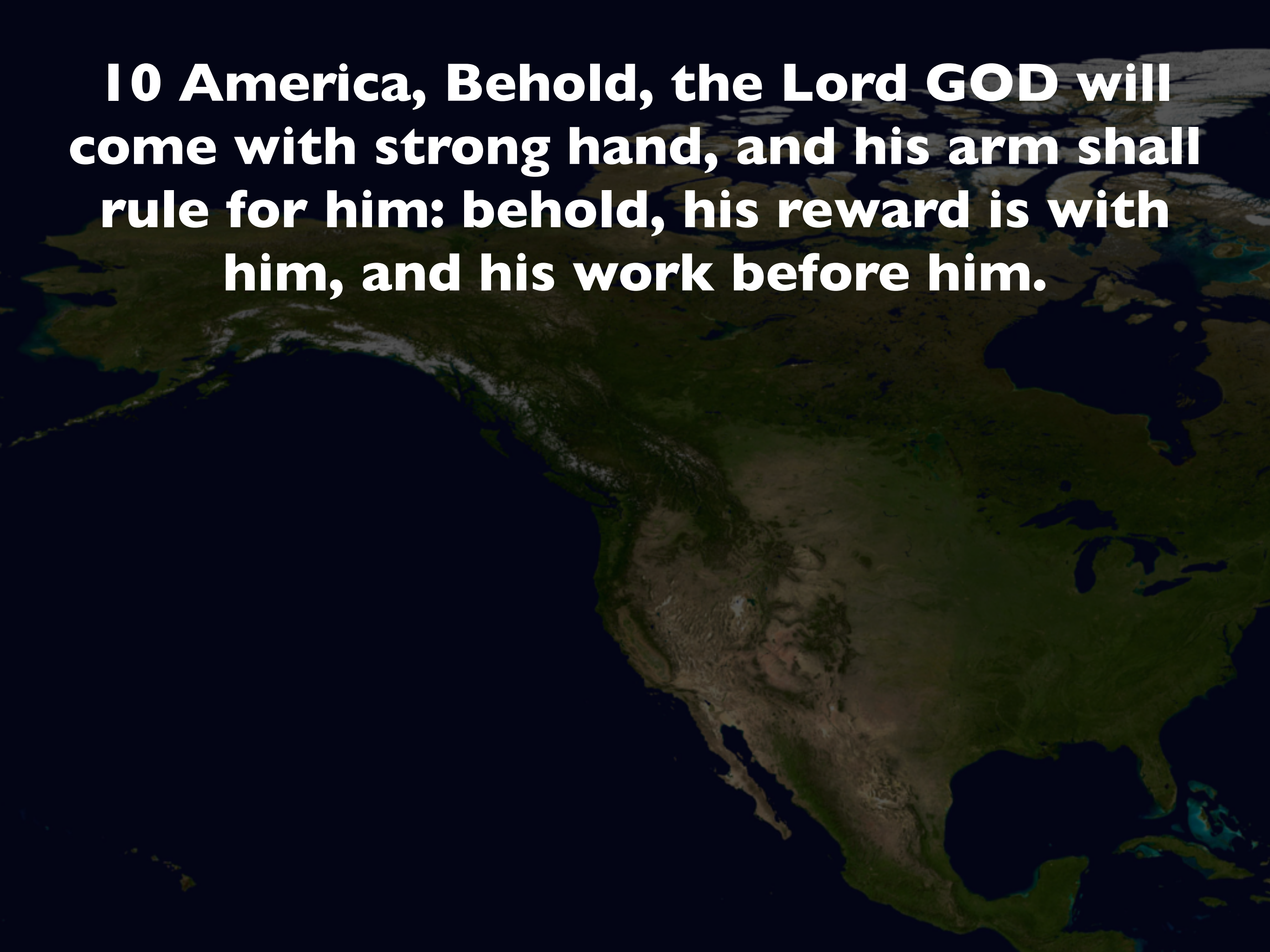




*** We say that you will Lift up your voice

him, and his work before him.**






**I I He shall feed his flock in America like

are with young.**

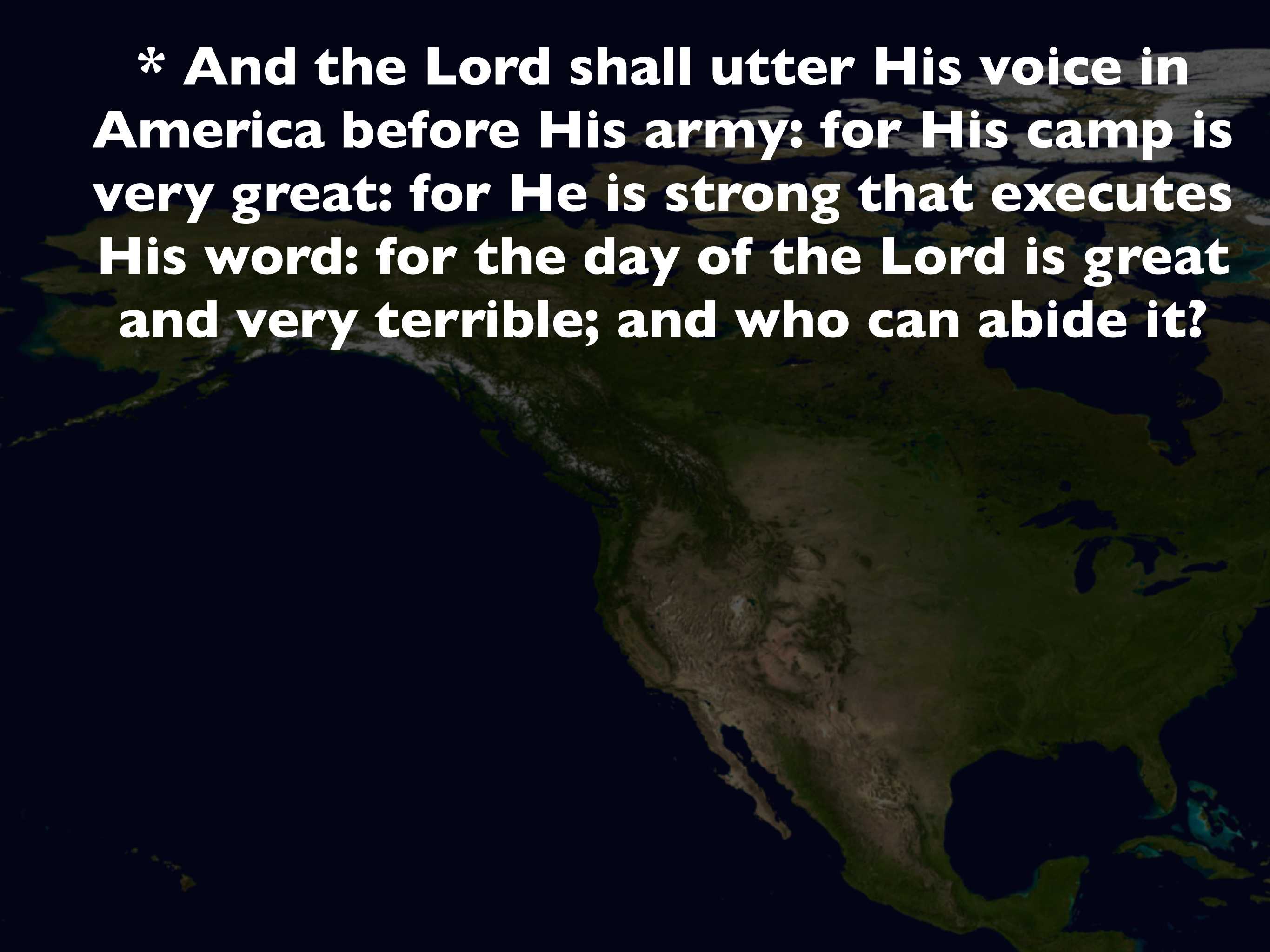

*** Thus says the Lord of hosts; The children of Israel, the children of Judah, and America were oppressed together: and all that took them captives held them fast; they refused to let them go.**

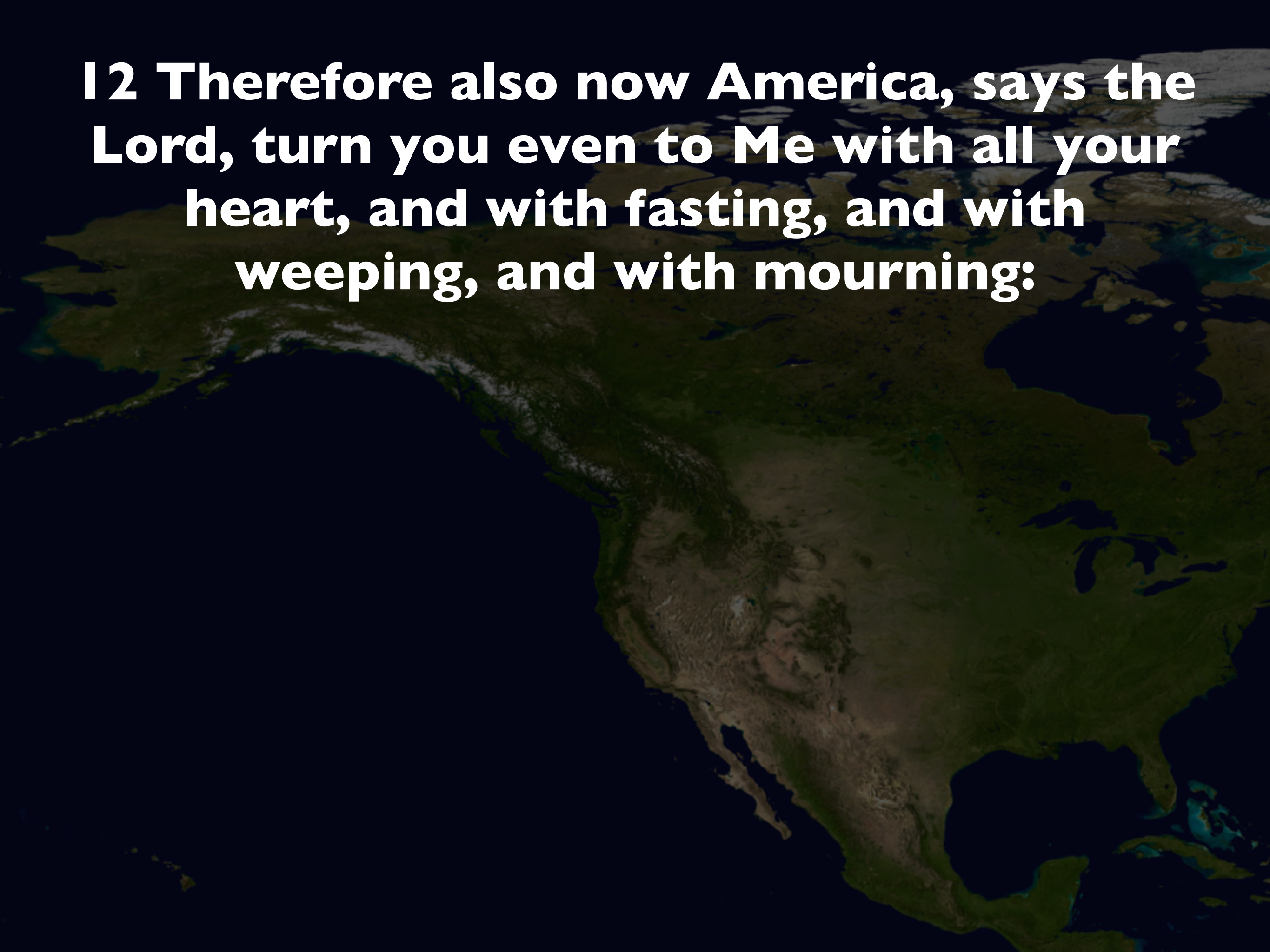


**34 Their Redeemer is strong; the Lord of

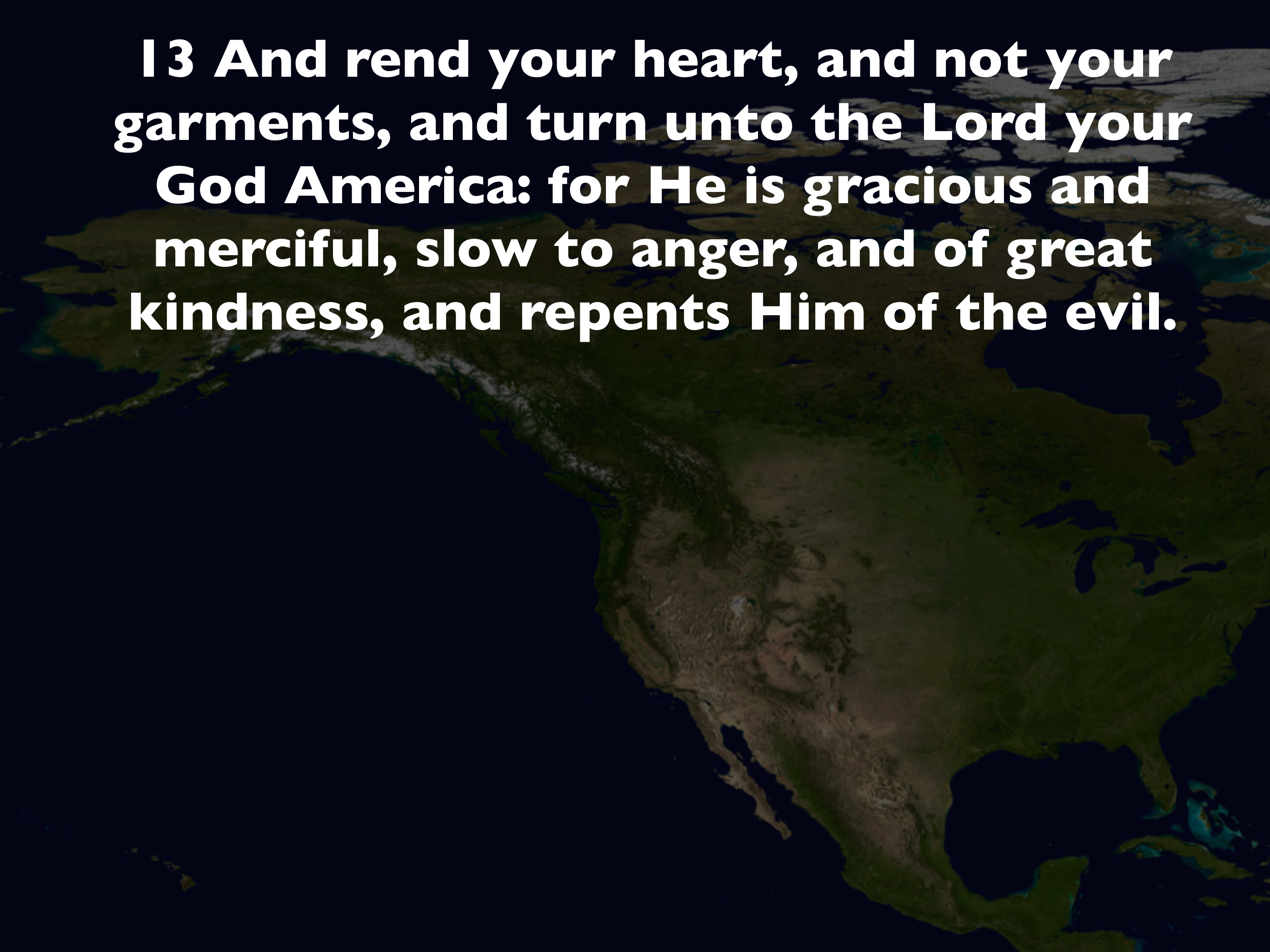
