> 1) Speak Calm and Peace Over the People

Philippians 4:6-7, Isaiah 41:10, John 14:27, Matthew 6:27,34,
Psalm 16:8, Psalm 4:8

- Philippians 4:6-7 - 6 Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God. 7 And the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.

- Isaiah 41:10 - Fear thou not; for I am with thee: be not dismayed; for I am thy God: I will strengthen thee; yea, I will help thee; yea, I will uphold thee with the right hand of my righteousness.

- John 14:27 - Peace I leave with you, my peace I give unto you: not as the world giveth, give I unto you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.

- Matthew 6:27,34 (AMPC) - 27 And who of you by worrying and being anxious can add one unit of measure (cubit) to his stature or to the span of his life? 34 So do not worry or be anxious about tomorrow, for tomorrow will have worries and anxieties of its own. Sufficient for each day is its own trouble.

- Psalm 16:8 - I have set the Lord always before me: because he is at my right hand, I shall not be moved.

- Psalm 4:8 (AMPC) - In peace I will both lie down and sleep, for You, Lord, alone make me dwell in safety and confident trust.

> 2) Reassure the People of God's Goodness and Faithfulness

Jeremiah 29:11, Psalm 46:10, 2 Thessalonians 3:3, Zephaniah 3:17, Psalm 23:1-2,23:4-6

- Jeremiah 29:11 (AMPC) - For I know the thoughts and plans that I have for you, says the Lord, thoughts and plans for welfare and peace and not for evil, to give you hope in your final outcome.

- Psalm 46:10 - Be still, and know that I am God: I will be exalted among the heathen, I will be exalted in the earth.

- 2 Thessalonians 3:3 (AMPC) - Yet the Lord is faithful, and He will strengthen [you] and set you on a firm foundation and guard you from the evil [one].

- Zephaniah 3:17 - The Lord thy God in the midst of thee is mighty; he will save, he will rejoice over thee with joy; he will rest in his love, he will joy over thee with singing.

- Psalm 23:1-2,4-6 - 1 The Lord is my shepherd; I shall not want. 2 He maketh me to lie down in green pastures: he leadeth me beside the still waters. 4 Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil: for thou art with me; thy rod and thy staff they comfort me. 5 Thou preparest a table before me in the presence of mine enemies: thou anointest my head with oil; my cup runneth over. 6 Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life: and I will dwell in the house of the Lord for ever.

> 3) Call the People to Take Refuge in the Lord

Psalm 5:11, Isaiah 26:3, Psalm 31:19-20, Psalm 32:7, Psalm 27:5

- Psalm 5:11 (AMPC) - But let all those who take refuge and put their trust in You rejoice; let them ever sing and shout for joy, because You make a covering over them and defend them; let those also who love Your name be joyful in You and be in high spirits.

- Isaiah 26:3 - Thou wilt keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on thee: because he trusteth in thee.

- Psalm 31:19-20 (AMPC) - 19 Oh, how great is Your goodness, which You have laid up for those who fear, revere, and worship You, goodness which You have wrought for those who trust and take refuge in You before the sons of men! 20 In the secret place of Your presence You hide them from the plots of men; You keep them secretly in Your pavilion from the strife of tongues.

- Psalm 32:7 (AMPC) - You are a hiding place for me; You, Lord, preserve me from trouble, You surround me with songs and shouts of deliverance.

- Psalm 27:5 (AMPC) - For in the day of trouble He will hide me in His shelter; in the secret place of His tent will He hide me; He will set me high upon a rock.

> 4) That The People Will Understand and Trust That What Is Happening Is For Their Highest Good and Protection

Proverbs 3:5-6, Proverbs 2:6-8, Psalm 116:6, Romans 8:31, Romans 13:1-4, Psalm 32:10, Proverbs 21:15, Romans 16:20

- Proverbs 3:5-6 (AMPC) - 5 Lean on, trust in, and be confident in the Lord with all your heart and mind and do not rely on your own insight or understanding. 6 In all your ways know, recognize, and acknowledge Him, and He will direct and make straight and plain your paths.

- Proverbs 2:6-8 (AMPC) - 6 For the Lord gives skillful and godly Wisdom; from His mouth come knowledge and understanding. 7 He hides away sound and godly Wisdom and stores it for the righteous (those who are upright and in right standing with Him); He is a shield to those who walk uprightly and in integrity, 8 That He may guard the paths of justice; yes, He preserves the way of His saints.

- Psalm 116:6 - The Lord preserveth the simple: I was brought low, and he helped me.

- Romans 8:31 - What shall we then say to these things? If God be for us, who can be against us?

*- Romans 13:1-4 (AMPC) - 1 Let every person be loyally subject to the governing (civil) authorities. For there is no authority except from God [by His permission, His sanction], and those that exist do so by God's appointment. 2 Therefore he who resists and sets himself up against the authorities resists what God has appointed and arranged [in divine order]. And those who resist will bring down judgment upon themselves [receiving the penalty due them]. 3 For civil authorities are not a terror to [people of] good conduct, but to [those of] bad behavior. Would you have no dread of him who is in authority? Then do what is right and you will receive his approval and commendation. 4 For he is God's servant for your good. But if you do wrong, [you should dread him and] be afraid, for he does not bear

and wear the sword for nothing. He is God's servant to execute His wrath (punishment, vengeance) on the wrongdoer.

- Psalm 32:10 - Many sorrows shall be to the wicked: but he that trusteth in the Lord, mercy shall compass him about.

- Proverbs 21:15 (AMPC) - When justice is done, it is a joy to the righteous (the upright, in right standing with God), but to the evildoers it is dismay, calamity, and ruin.

- Romans 16:20 - And the God of peace shall bruise Satan under your feet shortly. The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you. Amen.

> 5) That God Will Enable Martial Law to Happen With Order, and That Everything Will Take Place As God Has Ordained

Matthew 6:9-10, Proverbs 16:3, Psalm 32:8, Proverbs 16:4, Romans 8:28, Job 42:2, Isaiah 46:10, Romans 11:36

- Matthew 6:9-10 (AMPC) - 9 Our Father Who is in heaven, hallowed (kept holy) be Your name. 10 Your kingdom come, Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven.

- Proverbs 16:3 (AMPC) - 3 Roll your works upon the Lord [commit and trust them wholly to Him; He will cause your thoughts to become agreeable to His will, and] so shall your plans be established and succeed.

- Psalm 32:8 (AMPC) - 8 I [the Lord] will instruct you and teach you in the way you should go; I will counsel you with My eye upon you.

- Proverbs 16:4 (AMPC) - 4 The Lord has made everything [to accommodate itself and contribute] to its own end and His own purpose...

- Romans 8:28 - 28 And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to his purpose.

- Job 42:2 (AMPC) - 2 I know that You can do all things, and that no thought or purpose of Yours can be restrained or thwarted.

- Isaiah 46:10 (AMPC) - 10 Declaring the end and the result from the beginning, and from ancient times the things that are not yet done, saying, My counsel shall stand, and I will do all My pleasure and purpose,

- Romans 11:36 (AMPC) - 36 For from Him and through Him and to Him are all things. [For all things originate with Him and come from Him; all things live through Him, and all things center in and tend to consummate and to end in Him.] To Him be glory forever! Amen (so be it).
