⁶ I will not be afraid of ten thousands of people, that have set *themselves* against me round about.

⁷ Arise, O LORD; save me, O my God: for thou hast smitten all mine enemies *upon* the cheek bone; thou hast broken the teeth of the ungodly.

⁸ Salvation *belongeth* unto the LORD: thy blessing *is* upon thy people. Selah.

Psalm 57:3 (KJV)

³ He shall send from heaven, and save me *from* the reproach of him that would swallow me up. Selah. God shall send forth his mercy and his truth.

Psalm 59:2 (KJV)

² Deliver me from the workers of iniquity, and save me from bloody men.

Psalm 109:26 (KJV)

²⁶ Help me, O LORD my God: O save me according to thy mercy:

Psalm 138:7-8 (KJV)

⁷ Though I walk in the midst of trouble, thou wilt revive me: thou shalt stretch forth thine hand against the wrath of mine enemies, and thy right hand shall save me.

Psalm 27:1 (KJV)

¹ The LORD *is* my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? the LORD *is* the strength of my life; of whom shall I be afraid?

Psalm 27:14 (KJV)

¹⁴ Wait on the LORD: be of good courage, and he shall strengthen thine heart: wait, I say, on the LORD.

Psalm 31:24 (KJV)

²⁴ Be of good courage, and he shall strengthen your heart, all ye that hope in the LORD.

Psalm 89:20-26 (KJV)

²⁰ I have found David my servant; with my holy oil have I anointed him:

²¹ With whom my hand shall be established: mine arm also shall strengthen him.

²² The enemy shall not exact upon him; nor the son of wickedness afflict him.

²³ And I will beat down his foes before his face, and plague them that hate him.

²⁴ But my faithfulness and my mercy *shall be* with him: and in my name shall his horn be exalted.

²⁵ I will set his hand also in the sea, and his right hand in the rivers.

Psalms 37:30-34 (KJV)

³⁰ The mouth of the righteous speaketh wisdom, and his tongue talketh of judgment.

³¹ The law of his God *is* in his heart; none of his steps shall slide.

³² The wicked watcheth the righteous, and seeketh to slay him.

³³ The LORD will not leave him in his hand, nor condemn him when he is judged.

³⁴ Wait on the LORD, and keep his way, and he shall exalt thee to inherit the land: when the wicked are cut off, thou shalt see *it*.

Psalms 49:3 (KJV)

³ My mouth shall speak of wisdom; and the meditation of my heart *shall be* of understanding.

Psalms 51:6 (KJV)

⁶ Behold, thou desirest truth in the inward parts: and in the hidden *part* thou shalt make me to know wisdom.

Psalms 90:12 (KJV)

¹² So teach *us* to number our days, that we may apply *our* hearts unto wisdom.

Psalms 111:10 (KJV)

¹⁰ The fear of the LORD *is* the beginning of wisdom: a good understanding have all they that do *his commandments*: his praise endureth for ever.

Proverbs 1:2-3 (KJV)

² To know wisdom and instruction; to perceive the words of understanding;

³ To receive the instruction of wisdom, justice, and judgment, and equity;

Proverbs 2:6-12 (KJV)

⁶ For the LORD giveth wisdom: out of his mouth *cometh* knowledge and understanding.

⁷ He layeth up sound wisdom for the righteous: *he is* a buckler to them that walk uprightly.

⁸ He keepeth the paths of judgment, and preserveth the way of his saints.

⁹ Then shalt thou understand righteousness, and judgment, and equity; *yea*, every good path.

¹⁰ When wisdom entereth into thine heart, and knowledge is pleasant unto thy soul;

¹¹ Discretion shall preserve thee, understanding shall keep thee:

¹² To deliver thee from the way of the evil *man*, from the man that speaketh froward things;

Proverbs 4:11-13 (KJV)

¹¹ I have taught thee in the way of wisdom; I have led thee in right paths.

¹² When thou goest, thy steps shall not be straitened; and when thou runnest, thou shalt not stumble.

¹³ Take fast hold of instruction; let *her* not go: keep her; for she *is* thy life.

²⁴ The father of the righteous shall greatly rejoice: and he that begetteth a wise *child* shall have joy of him.
