- ⁹ After this manner therefore pray ye: Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name.
- ¹⁰ Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth, as *it is* in heaven.

Luke 1:31-33 (KJV)

- And, behold, thou shalt conceive in thy womb, and bring forth a son, and shalt call his name JESUS.
- ³² He shall be great, and shall be called the Son of the Highest: and the Lord God shall give unto him the throne of his father David:
- ³³ And he shall reign over the house of Jacob for ever; and of his kingdom there shall be no end.

Isaiah 9:6 (KJV)

⁶ For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given: and the government shall be upon his shoulder: and his name shall be called Wonderful, Counsellor, The mighty God, The everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace.

Psalm 40:7-8 (KJV)

- ⁷ Then said I, Lo, I come: in the volume of the book *it is* written of me,
- ⁸ I delight to do thy will, O my God: yea, thy law *is* within my heart.

Psalm 143:8-11 (KJV)

- ⁸ Cause me to hear thy lovingkindness in the morning; for in thee do I trust: cause me to know the way wherein I should walk; for I lift up my soul unto thee.
- ⁹ Deliver me, O LORD, from mine enemies: I flee unto thee to hide me.
- ¹⁰ Teach me to do thy will; for thou *art* my God: thy spirit *is* good; lead me into the land of uprightness.
- ¹¹ Quicken me, O LORD, for thy name's sake: for thy righteousness' sake bring my soul out of trouble.

Matthew 26:41-4 (KJV)

- Watch and pray, that ye enter not into temptation (a proving through adversity): the spirit indeed *is* willing, but the flesh *is* weak.
- O my Father, if this cup may not pass away from me, except I drink it, thy will be done.

Hebrews 10:7-10 (KJV)

⁷ Then said I, Lo, I come (in the volume of the book it is written of me,) to do thy will, O God.

- ⁸ Above when he said, Sacrifice and offering and burnt offerings and *offering* for sin thou wouldest not, neither hadst pleasure *therein*; which are offered by the law;

Mark 1:14-15 (KJV)

- ¹⁴ Now after that John was put in prison, Jesus came into Galilee, preaching the gospel of the kingdom of God,
- And saying, The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand: repent ye, and believe the gospel.

Mark 9:1 (KJV)

¹ And he said unto them, Verily I say unto you, That there be some of them that stand here, which shall not taste of death, till they have seen the kingdom of God come with power.

Matthew 4:16-17 (KJV)

- ¹⁶ The people which sat in darkness saw great light; and to them which sat in the region and shadow of death light is sprung up.
- ¹⁷ From that time Jesus began to preach, and to say, Repent: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.

Mark 12:32-34 (KJV)

- ³³ And to love him with all the heart, and with all the understanding, and with all the soul, and with all the strength, and to love *his* neighbor as himself, is more than all whole burnt offerings and sacrifices.

Matthew 4:23 (KJV)

²³ And Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching

the gospel of the kingdom, and healing all manner of sickness and all manner of disease among the people.

Luke 9:1-2 (KJV)

- ¹ Then he called his twelve disciples together, and gave them power and authority over all devils, and to cure diseases.
- ² And he sent them to preach the kingdom of God, and to heal the sick.

Luke 9:11 (KJV)

¹¹ And the people, when they knew *where He went*, followed him: and he received them, and spake unto them of the kingdom of God, and healed them that had need of healing.

Luke 9:60-62 (KJV)

- Jesus said unto him, Let the dead bury their dead: but go thou and preach the kingdom of God.
- ⁶¹ And another also said, Lord, I will follow thee; but let me first go bid them farewell, which are at home at my house.
- ⁶² And Jesus said unto him, No man, having put his hand to the plough, and looking back, is fit for the kingdom of God.

Luke 18:29-30 (KJV)

- ²⁹ And he said unto them, Verily I say unto you, There is no man that hath left house, or parents, or brethren, or wife, or children, for the kingdom of God's sake,
- ³⁰ Who shall not receive manifold more in this present time, and in the world to come life everlasting.

Luke 10:8-9 (KJV)

- ⁸ And into whatsoever city ye enter, and they receive you, eat such things as are set before you:

Matthew 12:25,28 (KJV)

- ²⁵ And Jesus knew their thoughts, and said unto them, Every kingdom divided against itself is brought to desolation; and every city or house divided against itself shall not stand:
- ²⁸ But if I cast out devils by the Spirit of God, then the kingdom of God is come unto you.

Matthew 13:10-11 (KJV)

- ¹⁰ And the disciples came, and said unto him, Why speak thou unto them in parables?
- ¹¹ He answered and said unto them, Because it is given unto you to know the mysteries of the kingdom of heaven, but to them it is not given.

Matthew 13:43 (KJV)

⁴³ Then shall the righteous shine forth as the sun in the kingdom of their Father. Who hath ears to hear, let him hear.

Matthew 16:16-19 (KJV)

- ¹⁶ Thou art the Christ, the Son of the living God.
- ¹⁷ And Jesus answered and said unto him, Blessed art thou, for flesh and blood hath not revealed *it* unto thee, but my Father which is in heaven.
- ¹⁸ And upon this rock I will build my church; and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it.
- ¹⁹ And I will give unto thee the keys of the kingdom of heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.

Matthew 18:3-4 (KJV)

- ¹ Then shall the kingdom of heaven be likened unto ten virgins, which took their lamps, and went forth to meet the bridegroom.
- ² And five of them were wise, and the wise took oil in their vessels with their lamps.
- ⁵ While the bridegroom tarried, they all slumbered and slept.
- ⁶ And at midnight there was a cry made, Behold, the bridegroom comes; go ye out to meet him.
- ¹⁰ And the bridegroom came; and they that were ready went in with him to the marriage: and the door was shut.

Matthew 25:33-40 (KJV)

³ Jesus answered and said unto him, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man

be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God.

- ⁵ Jesus answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born of water and *of* the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God.
- ⁶ That which is born of the flesh is flesh; and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit.

Romans 14:17 (KJV)

¹⁷ For the kingdom of God is not meat and drink; but righteousness, and peace, and joy in the Holy Ghost.

1 Corinthians 4:19-20 (KJV)

- ¹⁹ But I will come to you shortly, if the Lord will, and will know, not the speech of them which are puffed up, but the power.
- ²⁰ For the kingdom of God *is* not in word, but in power.

1 Thessalonians 2:12 (KJV)
