3. Give them the ability to finish their Job

² The God who girds me with strength and makes my way perfect?

³³ He makes my feet like hinds' feet [able to stand firmly or make progress on the dangerous heights of testing and trouble]; He sets me securely upon my high places.

³⁴ He teaches my hands to war, so that my arms can bend a bow of bronze.

³⁵ You have also given me the shield of Your salvation, and Your right hand has held me up; Your gentleness *and* condescension have made me great.

³⁶ You have given plenty of room for my steps under me, that my feet would not slip.

³⁷ I pursued my enemies and overtook them; neither did I turn again till they were consumed.

¹Contend, O Lord, with those who contend with me; fight against those who fight against me!

²Take hold of shield and buckler, and stand up for my help!

³Draw out also the spear and javelin *and* close up the way of those who pursue *and* persecute me. Say to me, I am your deliverance!

⁴Let them be put to shame and dishonor; let them be turned back and confounded!

⁵Let them be as chaff before the wind, with the ^[a]Angel of the Lord driving them on!

⁶Let their way be through dark and slippery places, with the Angel of the Lord pursuing *and* afflicting them.
