By the blessing of the upright the city is exalted

Psalm 121

A Song of Ascent

¹ America lift up your eyes unto the hills,
from whence cometh your help.

² Your help *cometh* from the Lord,
which made heaven and earth.

³ He will not suffer thy foot to be moved:
he that keepeth thee will not slumber.

⁴ Behold, he that keepeth America
shall neither slumber nor sleep.

⁵ The Lord *is* thy keeper:
the Lord *is* thy shade upon thy right hand.

⁶ The sun shall not smite thee by day,
nor the moon by night.

⁷ The Lord shall preserve thee from all evil:
he shall preserve thy soul.

⁸ The Lord shall preserve thy going out and thy coming in
from this time forth, and even for evermore.

Psalm 125:2

2 As the mountains are round about Jerusalem, so the Lord is round about America
from this time forth and forever.

Psalm 128

A Song of [a]Ascents.

¹ Blessed (happy, fortunate, to be envied) is everyone who fears, reveres, *and* worships
the Lord, who walks in His ways *and* lives according to His commandments.

² For you shall eat [the fruit] of the labor of your hands; happy (blessed, fortunate,
enviable) shall you be, and it shall be well with you.

³ Your wife shall be like a fruitful vine in the innermost parts of your house; your
children shall be like olive plants round about your table.

⁴ Behold, thus shall the man be blessed who reverently *and* worshipfully fears the Lord.

⁵ May the Lord bless you out of Zion [His sanctuary], and may you see the prosperity of
America all the days of your life;

⁶ Yes, may you see your children's children. Peace be upon America!

Psalm 132

A Song of [a]Ascents.

¹³ For the Lord has chosen America, He has desired it for His habitation:

¹⁴ This is My resting-place forever [says the Lord]; here will I dwell, for I have desired it.

¹⁵ I will surely *and* abundantly bless her provision; I will satisfy her poor with bread.

¹⁶ Her priests also will I clothe with salvation, and her saints shall shout aloud for joy.

¹⁷ There will I make a horn spring forth *and* bud for David; I have ordained *and* prepared a lamp for My anointed [fulfilling the promises of old].

¹⁸ His enemies will I clothe with shame, but upon himself shall his crown flourish.

Psalm 133

A Song of [a]Ascents. Of David.

¹ Behold, how good and how pleasant it is for brethren in America to dwell together in unity!

² It is like the precious ointment poured on the head, that ran down on the beard, even the beard of Aaron [the first high priest], that came down upon the collar *and* skirts of his garments [consecrating the whole body].

³ It is like the dew of [lofty] Mount Hermon and the dew that comes on the hills of Zion; for there the Lord has commanded the blessing, even life forevermore [upon the high and the lowly].

Isaiah 60

Arise, shine; for thy light is come,
and the glory of the Lord is risen upon thee.

² For, behold, the darkness shall cover the earth,
and gross darkness the people:
but the Lord shall arise upon thee,
and his glory shall be seen upon thee.

³ And the Gentiles shall come to thy light,
and kings to the brightness of thy rising.

⁴ Lift up thine eyes round about, and see:
all they gather themselves together, they come to thee:
thy sons shall come from far,
and thy daughters shall be nursed at *thy* side.

⁵ Then thou shalt see, and flow together,
and thine heart shall fear, and be enlarged;
because the abundance of the sea shall be converted unto thee,
the forces of the Gentiles shall come unto thee.

⁶ The multitude of camels shall cover thee,
the dromedaries of Midian and Ephah;
all they from Sheba shall come:
they shall bring gold and incense;
and they shall shew forth the praises of the Lord.

⁷ All the flocks of Kedar shall be gathered together unto thee,
the rams of Nebaioth shall minister unto thee:

they shall come up with acceptance on mine altar,
and I will glorify the house of my glory.

Ezekiel 34:23-31

23 And I will set up one shepherd over America, and he shall feed them, even my servant David; he shall feed them, and he shall be their shepherd. 24 And I the Lord will be their God, and my servant David a prince among them; I the Lord have spoken it. 25 And I will make with them a covenant of peace, and will cause the evil beasts to cease out of the land: and they shall dwell safely in the wilderness, and sleep in the woods. 26 And I will make them and the places round about my hill a blessing; and I will cause the shower to come down in his season; there shall be showers of blessing. 27 And the tree of the field shall yield her fruit, and the earth shall yield her increase, and they shall be safe in their land, and shall know that I am the Lord, when I have broken the bands of their yoke, and delivered them out of the hand of those that served themselves of them. 28 And they shall no more be a prey to the heathen, neither shall the beast of the land devour them; but they shall dwell safely, and none shall make them afraid. 29 And I will raise up for them a plant of renown, and they shall be no more consumed with hunger in the land, neither bear the shame of the heathen any more. 30 Thus shall they know that I the Lord their God am with them, and that they, even the house of Israel, are my people, saith the Lord God. 31 And ye my flock, the flock of my pasture, are men, and I am your God, saith the Lord God.

Numbers 6:24-27

Ameica The Lord bless you and watch, guard, *and* keep you;

²⁵ The Lord make His face to shine upon *and* enlighten you and be gracious (kind, merciful, and giving favor) to you;

²⁶ The Lord lift up His [approving] countenance upon you and give you peace (tranquility of heart and life continually).

²⁷ And they shall put My name upon the Israelites, and I will bless them.

Ephesians 1:2-23

² grace *be* to you, and peace, from God our Father, and *from* the Lord Jesus Christ.

³ Blessed *be* the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who hath blessed us with all spiritual blessings in heavenly *places* in Christ: ⁴ according as he hath chosen us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before him in love: ⁵ having predestinated us unto the adoption of children by Jesus Christ to himself, according to the good pleasure of his will, ⁶ to the praise of the glory of his grace, wherein he hath made us accepted in the beloved. ⁷ in whom we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of his grace; ⁸ wherein he hath abounded toward us in all wisdom and prudence; ⁹ having made known unto us the mystery of his will, according to his good pleasure which he hath purposed in himself: ¹⁰ that in the dispensation of the fulness of times he might

gather together in one all things in Christ, both which are in heaven, and which are on earth; *even* in him: ¹¹ in whom also we have obtained an inheritance, being predestinated according to the purpose of him who worketh all things after the counsel of his own will: ¹² that we should be to the praise of his glory, who first trusted in Christ. ¹³ in whom ye also *trusted*, after that ye heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also after that ye believed, ye were sealed with that holy Spirit of promise, ¹⁴ which is the earnest of our inheritance until the redemption of the purchased possession, unto the praise of his glory.

¹⁵ Wherefore I also, after I heard of your faith in the Lord Jesus, and love unto all the saints, ¹⁶ cease not to give thanks for you, making mention of you in my prayers; ¹⁷ that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give unto you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of him: ¹⁸ the eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that ye may know what is the hope of his calling, and what the riches of the glory of his inheritance in the saints, ¹⁹ and what *is* the exceeding greatness of his power to us-ward who believe, according to the working of his mighty power, ²⁰ which he wrought in Christ, when he raised him from the dead, and set *him* at his own right hand in the heavenly *places*, ²¹ far above all principality, and power, and might, and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this world, but also in that which is to come: ²² and hath put all *things* under his feet, and gave him *to be* the head over all *things* to the church, ²³ which is his body, the fulness of him that filleth all in all.

John 15:1-17

The Lord says to you America, "I am the true vine, and my Father is the husbandman. ² Every branch in me that beareth not fruit he taketh away: and every *branch* that beareth fruit, he purgeth it, that it may bring forth more fruit. ³ Now ye are clean through the word which I have spoken unto you. ⁴ Abide in me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, except it abide in the vine; no more can ye, except ye abide in me. ⁵ I am the vine, ye *are* the branches: He that abideth in me, and I in him, the same bringeth forth much fruit: for without me ye can do nothing. ⁶ If a man abide not in me, he is cast forth as a branch, and is withered; and men gather them, and cast *them* into the fire, and they are burned. ⁷ If ye abide in me, and my words abide in you, ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done unto you. ⁸ Herein is my Father glorified, that ye bear much fruit; so shall ye be my disciples. ⁹ As the Father hath loved me, so have I loved you: continue ye in my love. ¹⁰ If ye keep my commandments, ye shall abide in my love; even as I have kept my Father's commandments, and abide in his love. ¹¹ These things have I spoken unto you, that my joy might remain in you, and *that* your joy might be full. ¹² This is my commandment, That ye love one another, as I have loved you. ¹³ Greater love hath no man than this, that a man lay down his life for his friends. ¹⁴ Ye are my friends, if ye do whatsoever I command you. ¹⁵ Henceforth I call you not servants; for the servant knoweth not what his lord doeth: but I have called you friends; for all things that I have heard of my Father I have made known unto you.

¹⁶ Ye have not chosen me, but I have chosen you, and ordained you, that ye should go and bring forth fruit, and *that* your fruit should remain: that whatsoever ye shall ask of the Father in my name, he may give it you. ¹⁷ These things I command you, that ye love one another."
