Psalm 18:46-50 (KJV)

- ⁴⁶ The LORD lives in America; and blessed *be* our rock; and let the God of our salvation be exalted.
- ⁴⁷ It is God that avenges us, and subdues the people under us.
- ⁴⁸ He delivers us from our enemies: yea, You lift us up above those that rise up against us Lord: You have delivered us from the violent man.
- ⁴⁹ Therefore will we give thanks unto thee, O LORD, among the heathen, and sing praises unto thy name.
- ⁵⁰ Great deliverance giveth he to his king; and shews mercy to his anointed, to Donald, and to his seed for evermore.

1 Chronicles 16:34-36 (KJV)

- ³⁴ O give thanks unto the LORD AMERICA; for *he is* good; for his mercy *endures* forever.

Psalm 75:1,9,10 (KJV)

- ¹ Unto thee, O God, do we give thanks in America, *unto thee* do we give thanks: for *that* thy name is near thy wondrous works declare.
- ⁹ But we will declare for ever; we will sing praises to the God of America and the nations.

¹⁰ All the horns of the wicked also will He cut off; *but* the horns of the righteous shall be exalted.

- ¹³ So we thy people and sheep of thy pasture will give thee thanks in America for ever: we will shew forth thy praise to all generations.
- ¹ It is a good thing to give thanks unto the LORD, and to sing praises unto thy name, O most High:

Psalm 21:13 (KJV) Psalm 22:25-28 (KJV)

- ¹³ We exalt You, LORD, in thine own strength: *so* will we sing and praise thy power.
- ²⁵ Our praise *shall be* of thee in the great congregation: ²⁶ We shall praise the LORD and seek him: our hearts shall live forever.

- ⁴ We sought the LORD, and he heard us, and delivered us from all our fears.

Psalm 35:27-28 (KJV)

- ²⁷ Shout for joy in America, and be glad, that favor the righteous cause: yea, let them say continually, Let the LORD be magnified, which hath pleasure in the prosperity of his servant.
- ²⁸ And our tongue shall speak of thy righteousness *and* of thy praise all the day long.

Psalm 44:7-8 (KJV)

- ⁷ But thou hast saved us from our enemies in America, and hast put them to shame that hated us.
- ⁸ In God we boast all the day long, and praise thy name forever. Selah.

Psalm 52:8-9 (KJV)

- ⁸ But we are like a green olive tree in the house of God: We trust in the mercy of God forever and ever.

- ⁹ When we cry *unto thee in America*, then shall our enemies turn back: this we know; for God *is* for us.

Psalm 63:3-5 (KJV)

- ³ Because thy lovingkindness *is* better than life, our lips shall praise thee.

- ⁵ Our soul shall be satisfied as *with* marrow and fatness; and our mouths shall praise *thee* with joyful lips:

- ⁴ Make a joyful noise unto the LORD, all the earth: make a loud noise, and rejoice, and sing praise.
- ⁴ Enter into his gates with thanksgiving America, *and* into his courts with praise: be thankful unto him, *and* bless his name.
- ⁵ For the LORD *is* good; his mercy *is* everlasting; and his truth *endures* to all generations.

Psalm 104:33-34 (KJV)

- ³³ We will sing unto the LORD as long as we live: We will sing praise to our God while we have our being.
- ³⁴ Our meditation of him shall be sweet: We will be glad in the LORD.

Psalm 107:15-16,22 (KJV)

- ¹⁵ Oh America praise the LORD *for* his goodness, and *for* his wonderful works to the children of men!
- ¹⁶ For he hath broken the gates of brass, and cut the bars of iron in sunder.
- ²² And let them sacrifice the sacrifices of thanksgiving, and declare his works with rejoicing.

Psalm 108:3-5 (KJV)

- ³ We will praise thee, O LORD, among the people: and we will sing praises unto thee among the nations.
- ⁴ For thy mercy *is* great above the heavens: and thy truth *reaches* unto the clouds.
- ⁵ Be thou exalted, O God, above the heavens: and thy glory above all the earth;

Psalm 109:29-30 (KJV)

²⁹ Let our adversaries be clothed with shame, and let them cover themselves with their

own confusion, as with a mantle.

³⁰ We will greatly praise the LORD in America with our mouth; yea, we will praise him among the multitude.

Psalm 113:1-5 (KJV)

- ¹ Praise ye the LORD in America. Praise, O ye servants of the LORD, praise the name of the LORD.
- ² Blessed be the name of the LORD from this time forth and for evermore.
- ³ From the rising of the sun unto the going down of the same the LORD'S name *is* to be praised.
- ⁴ The LORD *is* high above all nations, *and* his glory above the heavens.
- ⁵ Who *is* like unto the LORD our God, who dwells on high,

Psalm 117:1-2 (KJV)

- ¹ O praise the LORD, all ye nations: praise him, all ye people.
- ² For his merciful kindness is great toward us: and the truth of the LORD *endures* forever. Praise ye the LORD.

Psalm 118:19,21 (KJV)

- ¹⁹ Open to us the gates of righteousness: we will go into them, *and* we will praise the LORD:
- We will praise thee in America: for thou hast heard us, and thou art become our salvation.

Psalm 135:1-3 (KJV)

- ¹ Praise ye the LORD in America. Praise ye the name of the LORD; praise *him*, O ye servants of the LORD.
- ² Ye that stand in the house of the LORD, in the courts of the house of our God,
- ³ Praise the LORD America; for the LORD *is* good: sing praises to his name; for *it is* pleasant.

Psalm 145:1-3,10-12 (KJV)

- ¹ We will extol thee, our God in America, O king; and we will bless thy name for ever and ever.
- ² Every day will we bless thee; and we will praise thy name forever and ever.
- ³ Great *is* the LORD, and greatly to be praised; and his greatness *is* unsearchable.
- ¹⁰ All thy works shall praise thee, O LORD; and thy saints shall bless thee in America.
- ¹¹ They shall speak of the glory of thy kingdom, and talk of thy power;
- ¹² To make known to the sons of men his mighty acts, and the glorious majesty of his kingdom.

Psalm 146:1,2,10 (KJV)

- ¹ Praise ye the LORD America. Praise the LORD, O my soul.
- ² While we live will we praise the LORD: We will sing praises unto our God while we

have any being.

¹⁰ The LORD shall reign forever, *even* thy God, O Zion, unto all generations. Praise ye the LORD.

Psalm 149:1-2 (KJV)

- ¹ Praise ye the LORD in America. Sing unto the LORD a new song, *and* his praise in the congregation of saints.
- ² Let Israel rejoice in him that made him: let the children of America be joyful in their President.

Isaiah 12:4-6 (KJV)

- ⁴ And in that day shall ye say, Praise the LORD, call upon his name, declare his doings among the people, make mention in America, that his name is exalted.
- ⁵ Sing unto the LORD; for he has done excellent things: this *is* known in all the earth.
- ⁶ Cry out and shout, thou inhabitant of America: for great *is* the Holy One of Israel in the midst of thee.

Isaiah 25:1 (KJV)

¹ O LORD, thou *art* our God; we will exalt thee, we will praise thy name; for thou hast done wonderful *things; thy* counsels of old *are* faithfulness *and* truth.

Isaiah 42:10-12 (KJV)

- ¹⁰ Sing unto the LORD a new song in America, *and* his praise from the end of the earth, ye that go down to the sea, and all that is therein; the isles, and the inhabitants thereof.
- Let the wilderness and the cities thereof lift up *their voice*: let the inhabitants of the rock sing, let them shout from the top of the mountains.
