

11.19.2020 The Church Intercession with Blessings and Thanksgiving Repentance

Avi, as part of Your Church, we come before You in humility to repent

- For not serving You with a whole heart
- For not seeking Your wisdom and Your understanding, Your insights and Your discernments to know Your plans and how You do things
- For not seeking You to know You
- Oh, Father, have mercy on us.
- We repent for our arrogance and haughty pride
- For not being the salt – being asleep in the Light
- For our lackadaisical complacency and lukewarmness
- For compromise and trampling underfoot the blood of Yeshua
- For not being a Light to the nations
- For losing and rejecting a Love for The Truth, leaving an open door for the enemy to bring in his deceptions into the Church

Intercession

Avi, in the Name of Yeshua, we cry out to You

Lord, Send forth Your Light and Your Truth to reveal the deceptions loosed in the Church

Lord, we ask that You will pour out Your Light and Your Truth upon the hearts of Your Church that will cause how we see things to change.

Lord, cleanse us, purify us. Create in us a clean heart and a right spirit.

- Help us to see the depths of our misguided ways

Lord, give us eyes to see, ears to hear, and a heart to receive Your Truth.

Lord, bring down the high places, lift up the low places, straighten out the crooked places and smooth out the rough places so the glory of the Lord will appear and all humanity will see it.

Oh Lord, send Your breath to breathe over these dry bones. Come from the four winds, breathe on Your people that Your people will live.

Avi, Let repentance come. Send forth Your revival that Your Times of Refreshing will come.

Revive us, O Lord, from this comatose state we have lived in.

We pray for Reformation and Revival to break the powers of darkness that cannot be broken by any other means and that through this breaking, You will make us holy and pleasing in Your sight.

Avi, Bring forth Your prophetic reformation into Your body.

Put Your eyesalve upon our eyes that we may see as You see, not with the sight of our eyes but with righteous eyes of The Spirit.

Oh Lord God reveal The Kingdom to Your Church

- Pray for revelation to come to the Church that she might arise in the superior excellence of His Majesty and His might.
- Your Kingdom come; Your will be done
- Avi, we call Your will down from heaven to earth to manifest and function the way You have designed.

Avi, we pray for the Revelation of Jesus Christ yet to come.

- Bring forth a greater knowing that has been ordained for this time
- Avi, prepare Your Church to be able and ready to receive and embrace Your Revelation
- We pray that You will reveal Yourself to us.

Avi, in the Name of Yeshua, today we also pray for healing of those who have suffered as a result of their heritage.

- We pray for deep healing so they all can become testimonies and overcomers in You.

Avi, in the Name of Yeshua we pray from Isaiah 58:12 and ask that You come as the Repairer of the Breach

- So the ancient ruins will be rebuilt
- We ask You to raise up the foundations of buildings that have laid waste for many generations

- And restore the streets we all dwell in.

Avi, help Your Church be transformed into the likeness of Your Son, Yeshua: her brain, her vision, her heart, her soul.

- Avi, help the fruits of the Spirit come to full maturity in Your Body

Avi, Help us to walk in the Light as You are in the Light – clear, pure, holy.

¹⁴ You are the light of the world. A city set on a hill cannot be hidden.

¹⁵ Nor do men light a lamp and put it under a peck measure, but on a lampstand, and it gives light to all in the house.

¹⁶ Let your light so shine before men that they may see your moral excellence and your praiseworthy, noble, and good deeds and recognize and honor and praise and glorify your Father Who is in heaven.

Scriptures of Blessings to the Church

Psalm 138 AMPC

[A Psalm] of David.

¹ I will confess and praise You [O God] with my whole heart; before the gods will I sing praises to You.

² I will worship toward Your holy temple and praise Your name for Your loving-kindness and for Your truth and faithfulness; for You have exalted above all else Your name and Your word and You have magnified Your word above all Your name!

³ In the day when I called, You answered me; and You strengthened me with strength (might and inflexibility to temptation) in my inner self.

⁴ All the kings of the land shall give You credit and praise You, O Lord, for they have heard of the promises of Your mouth [which were fulfilled].

⁵ Yes, they shall sing of the ways of the Lord and joyfully celebrate His mighty acts, for great is the glory of the Lord.

⁶ For though the Lord is high, yet has He respect to the lowly [bringing them into fellowship with Him]; but the proud and haughty He knows and recognizes [only] at a distance.

⁷ Though I walk in the midst of trouble, You will revive me; You will stretch forth Your hand against the wrath of my enemies, and Your right hand will save me.

⁸ The Lord will perfect that which concerns me; Your mercy and loving-kindness, O Lord, endure forever—forsake not the works of Your own hands.

Jeremiah 30:19

¹⁹ Out of them [city and palace] will come songs of thanksgiving and the voices of those who make merry. And I will multiply them, and they will not be few; I will also glorify them, and they will not be small.

Psalm 24 AMPC**A Psalm of David.**

¹ The earth is the Lord's, and the fullness of it, the world and they who dwell in it.

² For He has founded it upon the seas and established it upon the currents and the rivers.

³ Who shall go up into the mountain of the Lord? Or who shall stand in His Holy Place?

⁴ He who has clean hands and a pure heart, who has not lifted himself up to falsehood or to what is false, nor sworn deceitfully.

⁵ He shall receive blessing from the Lord and righteousness from the God of his salvation.

⁶ This is the generation [description] of those who seek Him [who inquire of and for Him and of necessity require Him], who seek Your face, [O God of] Jacob. Selah [pause, and think of that]!

⁷ Lift up your heads, O you gates; and be lifted up, you age-abiding doors, that the King of glory may come in.

⁸ Who is the King of glory? The Lord strong and mighty, the Lord mighty in battle.

⁹ Lift up your heads, O you gates; yes, lift them up, you age-abiding doors, that the King of glory may come in.

¹⁰ Who is [He then] this King of glory? The Lord of hosts, He is the King of glory. Selah [pause, and think of that]!

Church of Jesus Christ, we bless you with the Word of the Lord

Matthew 5:2-12 AMP

¹When Jesus saw the crowds, He went up on the mountain; and when He was seated, His disciples came to Him. ²Then He began to teach them, saying,

³“Blessed [spiritually prosperous, happy, to be admired] are the poor in spirit [those devoid of spiritual arrogance, those who regard themselves as insignificant], for theirs is the kingdom of heaven [both now and forever].

⁴“Blessed [forgiven, refreshed by God’s grace] are those who mourn [over their sins and repent], for they will be comforted [when the burden of sin is lifted].

⁵“Blessed [inwardly peaceful, spiritually secure, worthy of respect] are the gentle [the kind-hearted, the sweet-spirited, the self-controlled], for they will inherit the earth.

⁶“Blessed [joyful, nourished by God’s goodness] are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness [those who actively seek right standing with God], for they will be [completely] satisfied.

⁷“Blessed [content, sheltered by God’s promises] are the merciful, for they will receive mercy.

⁸“Blessed [anticipating God’s presence, spiritually mature] are the pure in heart [those with integrity, moral courage, and godly character], for they will see God.

⁹“Blessed [spiritually calm with life-joy in God’s favor] are the makers and maintainers of peace, for they will [express His character and] be called the sons of God.

¹⁰“Blessed [comforted by inner peace and God’s love] are those who are persecuted for doing that which is morally right, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven [both now and forever].

¹¹“Blessed [morally courageous and spiritually alive with life-joy in God’s goodness] are you when people insult you and persecute you, and falsely

say all kinds of evil things against you because of [your association with] Me.

¹² Be glad and exceedingly joyful, for your reward in heaven is great [absolutely inexhaustible]; for in this same way they persecuted the prophets who were before you.

Isaiah 58:11 AMPC

¹¹ And the Lord shall guide you continually and satisfy you in drought and in dry places and make strong your bones. And you shall be like a watered garden and like a spring of water whose waters fail not.

Psalms 5:12 AMPC

¹² For You, Lord, will bless the [uncompromisingly] righteous [him who is upright and in right standing with You]; as with a shield You will surround him with goodwill (pleasure and favor).

II Corinthians 9:11 AMPC

¹¹ Thus you will be enriched in all things and in every way, so that you can be generous, and [your generosity as it is] administered by us will bring forth thanksgiving to God.

Colossians 3:16-17 AMPC

¹⁶ Let the word [spoken by] Christ (the Messiah) have its home [in your hearts and minds] and dwell in you in [all its] richness, as you teach and admonish and train one another in all insight and intelligence and wisdom [in spiritual things, and as you sing] psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, making melody to God with [His] grace in your hearts.

¹⁷ And whatever you do [no matter what it is] in word or deed, do everything in the name of the Lord Jesus and in [dependence upon] His Person, giving praise to God the Father through Him.

Numbers 6:24-27 AMPC

²⁴ The Lord bless you and watch, guard, and keep you;

²⁵ The Lord make His face to shine upon and enlighten you and be gracious (kind, merciful, and giving favor) to you;

²⁶ The Lord lift up His [approving] countenance upon you and give you peace (tranquility of heart and life continually).

²⁷ And they shall put My name upon the Israelites, and I will bless them.
