BACKPACK KIDS PROGRAM EXPANSION

CedarWood's Backpack Kids Program is growing! This October, we began making weekend food kits for 260 children and a few senior citizens in Washington's "Sky Valley," an area which includes the towns of Sultan and Gold Bar. For the past 9 years we have partnered with Kelly Clifton, Founder and Director of Operation Sky Valley, in supporting her "Operation Full Bellies" outreach, providing food for at-risk elementary school children enrolled in the Nation's free school lunch program.

Since 2021, school enrollment has been down due to mandated home-schooling and hybrid programs during a time of state-wide restrictions on in-school attendance. We have been packing 200 weekend food kits per month for Sultan and Gold Bar since then, but classroom attendance is increasing, so we are very excited to add an additional 60 kids to our feeding program every month.
